The Las Indias Cultural Centre is the meeting place of the district of Las Indias, on the western slope of the municipality, between 350 and 550 m above sea level. It is a municipal venue for community and cultural use, included in the Canary Islands circuit of performing-arts venues (MARES Programme), with a bar run under concession that serves as a daily meeting point.

It hosts public events, residents' meetings and the activities of the district's associations, and has served as the venue for debates of municipal interest, such as the round table on the future of the Fuente Santa held in 2014.

It stands next to the bus stop that bears its name, on the Las Indias road. Very close by, on the LP-2 above the district, the new Mirador de Las Indias viewpoint was opened in August 2026, with a *décima* poem by Miguel Martín Méndez, a native of the district, and a sculpture by Gustavo Díaz.

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
