Mirador de Los Canarios Rest Area

This rest area is at the western exit of Los Canarios, on the LP-2 main road, on the Volcano Route. It is a gravel esplanade with several picnic tables and benches, protected by a wooden railing, from which there are fine views of the San Antonio volcano, the village of Los Canarios and the sea. On the slope of the volcano you can make out the Roque Teneguía, the yellowish rock that holds the aboriginal engravings.

It is easy to reach by car from the village centre, with parking beside the road. It has no water or barbecues: it is a place to have a quiet bite to eat, look and move on. For a picnic area with a barbecue and toilets there is, very close by, the Los Canarios Rest Area, on the road to the football pitch.

It is part of the Viewpoints Route and of the municipality's Recreation Areas themed route. See also: Barrio Los Canarios.

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
